



Thank you for your interest in partnering with Skate Like a Girl. Over our 25 year history we have partnered with hundreds of different schools, community centers, and organizations to bring school-based skateboarding enrichment to youth in the greater Seattle, Portland, and San Francisco Bay area.. Please review the following information to ensure our program will be a good fit. We look forward to hearing from you.

**Skate Like a Girl can provide the following to your agency:**

- Gear
  - Helmets
  - Elbow/Knee/Wrist pads
  - Skateboards
- Coaches
  - CPR/First Aid certified
  - 1 to 7 staff to student ratio
  - Diverse staff, including female, male, and non-binary identified individuals
- Curriculum
  - Weekly themes, covering 5 Core Values of Skate Like a Girl
    - Confidence, resilience, self-advocacy, civic engagement, and leadership.
- Moveable small ramps & other obstacles pending availability

**Your agency must provide the following:**

- Space to host skateboarding programming
  - Covered or Indoor spaces are preferred (example: Gym or outdoor playcourt)
    - Riding surface must be relatively smooth
    - Ideally 3,000 sq. ft. of space or larger
    - Cleared by administration to be used by skateboards
  - Nearby skate parks, basketball courts, etc. work great (for dry days)
    - Must have a contingency plan for rain days (example: Indoor classroom reserved)
- Gear storage
  - Space to host helmets, skateboards, pads, and other supplies on site
  - Easily accessible for our staff on class days (example: provide keys to locked cabinet)
  - Locked up to prevent theft
- Administration Support
  - Roster of students
  - Skate Like a Girl waivers, signed by legal guardians, collected and presented prior to first class
- Fees for services – Prices depend on location, venue, staff to skater ratio, gear storage, etc.
  - Program rate: \$10-\$20/program hour/child\*
    - Majority of students in program do not qualify for free or reduced lunch
  - Subsidized rate: \$5-\$10/program hour/child
    - Majority of students in program qualify for free or reduced lunch
  - On occasion, Skate Like a Girl has capacity to host programs requiring an additional subsidy - please inquire
- Optional
  - Snacks
  - Additional volunteers or staff to support behavior management
