

WITCH HUNT FAQ:

What is Witch Hunt?

A city-wide skateboarding scavenger hunt with challenges, filming, and item collecting. Held on the Saturday of Wheels of Fortune weekend—a three-day extravaganza celebrating women, trans, and queer skaters. Witch Hunt is all about exploring, skating, and creating together, with the focus on creativity and community over strict rules.

Where do we meet?

At Seattle Center Skatepark aka SeaSk8

5th Ave N &, Broad St, Seattle, WA 98109

- **10:00 AM:** Arrive + sign up your team
- **12:00 PM:** The hunt begins

How long does it last?

You'll have **6 hours** to complete challenges across the city before heading to the final stop, 35th North Skate Shop on Capitol Hill, located at 1100 E Pike St, Seattle, WA 98122.

How do teams work?

- Teams are suggested to be **5–10 people total**
- We recommend **1-2 cars per team**, or better yet, do the day on bikes, boards, or public transit instead!
- All genders and ages are welcome (friends, family, dogs, etc.), but we ask that your team centers **queer, women, and/or trans skaters**

What kind of challenges are there?

There will be over 50 different challenges and they will be a mix of skateboarding and silly non-skate tasks. For example there may be challenges like:

- Fabi: Body varial transition trick
- Green bum: Grass hill bomb in buttboard position at Gasworks Park

There's no formal scoring or point system this year. So, just get out there, have fun, film clips, post along the way, and put together an edit. Edits and clips will be judged by a panel of highly esteemed witches and warlocks.

What's the item collection?

New this year, there will be hidden items scattered throughout the city at key locations. Collect as many as you can for a special prize at the end of the night.

Do we need to film?

You can definitely just do Witch Hunt as a soul skater, but if you do choose to film, here's what we are looking for:

- Post clips to your **Instagram Story** during the day and tag @theskatewitches and hashtag #wof13
- Throughout the day, timeline your best clips to make a 1 minute edit

You can film on:

- iPhone
- "Real" camera (please organize footage into a timeline if possible)

Where do we end the day?

At 35th North Skate Shop on Capitol Hill.

- **6:00 PM:** Turn in Witch Hunt clips / edits to the boys of Adjacency Bias
 - Food & refreshments will be in the shop
 - Photo inside the shop
 - Skate Jam outside the shop
- **8:00 PM:** Video screenings including Witch Hunt superlative awards
 - Yes, there will be a **trophy**

How do you "win"?

There's no single winner! Teams can be recognized in the following ways:

- Most secret items collected
- Best 1-minute edit
- Superlative awards

What awards are given?

- Best Edit (1-minute edit)
- Most Valuable Witch (best skater)
- Funniest Clip
- Best Slam
- Best Photo
- Best Dressed
